GUY'S DRESS CODE	
DO'S	DON'TS
Dress SEMI-FORMAL.	No jeans.
Dress pants with a belt.	No baggy pants or underwear showing.
Collared shirt or Dress shirt.	No T-shirts.

GIRLS' DRESS CODE	
DO'S	DON'TS
Dress SEMI-FORMAL...dress, skirt, or dress slacks.	No exposed midriff.
Wear a modest neckline and hemline.	No sheer or see-through dress/outfits.
Dresses may not be shorter than mid-thigh when arms are raised.	If the dress becomes inappropriate while dancing, you may be asked to leave. No extremely tight fitting dresses.

*If you are unsure about your choice of clothing, please ask an administrator beforehand.

<p>The theme of this year's homecoming dance is: "Night of Mystery" (A Masquerade Ball)-You do not have to wear a mask. The dance will be a lockdown; meaning once you enter, you will not be allowed to leave until 9:30pm and must be checked out by a parent or guardian.</p>
