Every student needs the training and parents need to have materials sent for them. This will need to be discussed at the next meeting – teacher members will research and report back.
- b. Safety and Security - Scary things happening in the neighborhoods. Teachers have reminded students of security measures. There are resources in the school to help kids who have been involved in uncomfortable situations. We want kids to be able to feel safe and happy in the school.
