On Monday during our Professional Learning Day, Mr. Jacobson and Mr. Bratton led our teachers through a process of self-reflection and sharing based around the statement above, which is directly linked to inclusion. For teachers to be able to offer the best from the time they spend with our diverse group of learners at NIS, it is of value to consider their own assumptions and to look at how those assumptions compare to current research, as well as the perspectives of others.

At NIS, we do not hire a specific type of teacher. We believe that a diverse group of teachers should mirror some of the diversity we see in our student population. Although, English as the taught language of inclusion means that the vast majority of our teachers are from outside Asia, it does not mean that they themselves don't have different learning styles, different assumptions about learning and different approaches towards interacting with students. One glance through our website may leave you with the impression that the only things all the teachers at NIS have in common is years of experience and high-level qualifications. That is not the case. We purposefully look for teachers who believe that inclusive practices encourage access to and participation in learning for all.
