A. Student Nutrition Department implementation

Myers

Change minimum cell on schedule to meet \$15.00 minimum wage requirement or eliminate lowest ranges. Reclassify employees is Personnel Commission purview. If Personnel Commission is willing to reclassify Food Service Assistant's to Range 36. We will combine 2 classifications. Satellite Food Service Assistant and Food Service Assistant will become one class called Student Nutrition Assistant. Then workers become interchangeable. Ultimate goal for department is working towards food prep at the sites instead of the main kitchens which then have to be delivered. Pilot is at El Toro and was successful.

With Commission action tonight, Oct 1<sup>st</sup> is when positions in the Food Service Department would be reclassified.

#### B. Bus Driver Incentive

Looking for ways to recruit bus drivers. Last year we were very near a crisis point and had to use contracted agency. Through collaboration, it was suggested to try a referral bonus to both the referral and the new employee. To date, we have paid two signing bonuses.
