CALENDAR 2019-2020

Our school calendar, in conjunction with calendars at Bryn Mawr and Gilman, is based on the following assumptions:

1. School will always begin on the Wednesday before Labor Day except when in conflict with a religious holiday.
2. Commencement for Roland Park Country School will be held on a Tuesday in June. Bryn Mawr's graduation will be the preceding Friday. Gilman's graduation will be on the preceding Sunday/Monday. We allow for approximately 176 academic days, but no fewer than 173.
3. Winter and spring breaks aim to provide a combined total of approximately three school weeks of vacation.
4. We will provide three and ½ professional development days: one and a half days in the fall and one day each in winter and spring.
5. The school will be closed for the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur when these holidays fall on a weekday. We will close for the Wednesday before Thanksgiving. The School will also be closed to observe Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, President's Day, Good Friday, and Memorial Day, observed.
