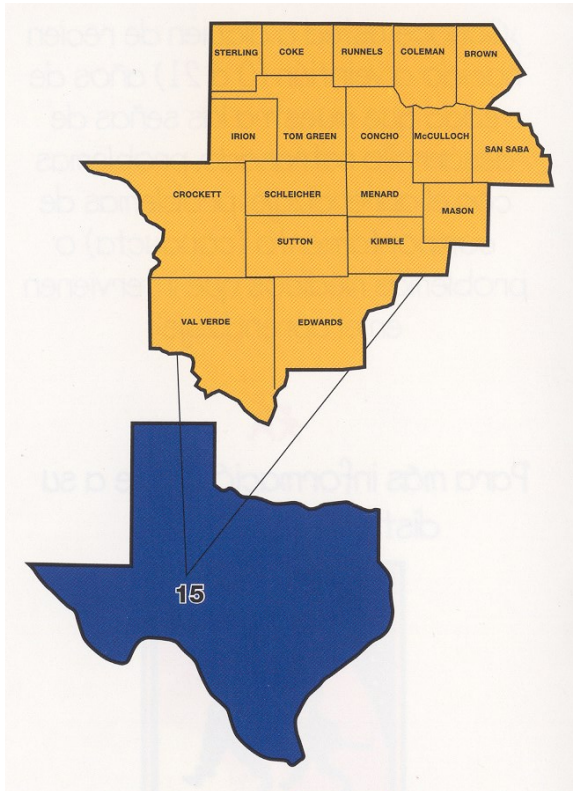

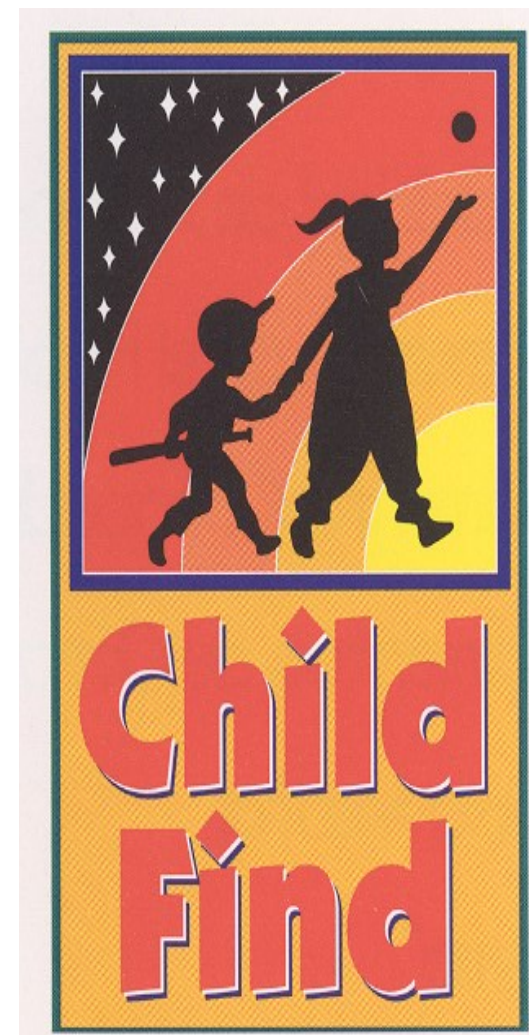

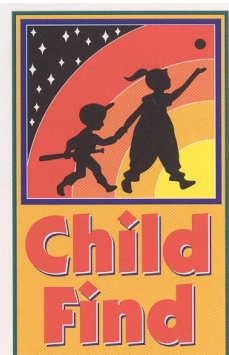

Special Education includes instruction and related services provided by local school districts for students who have the following conditions according to the state and federal criteria.

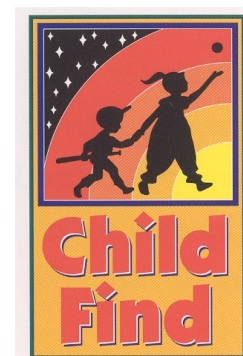
