Who is eligible to test?



- Seniors who have completed both years of a 2-year course
- Juniors or seniors who have completed a 1-year course
 - **IB Design Tech; IB Economics; IB ESS; IB World Religions**
- Completion of the Internal Assessment is required to test

Why Test?



- Holds students accountable to classwork ‘bell to bell’ and throughout the year
- Value of practicing high stakes testing in a supportive environment
- Junior Year scores can be included on college applications
- Exams provide the possibility for college credit at a much lower cost

University Recognition



- **NEW:** OR state law requires public universities to award credit for SL and HL exams with a score of 4+ or provide evidence for denial of credit (effective Fall 2020) - **JUNIORS**
- Most colleges award credit for HL exams with a score of 5+
- Some colleges recognize SL exam scores
- Credit awards range from 3-5 semester credits to 45 quarter credits depending on credentials, results, and university choice.

Credit Models for IB Diploma



- A la carte credits for individual exams
- Additional general education credits for IB Diploma earners, regardless of composite Diploma score
- Credit with an overall score of 30 points or more (45 credit hours) at Oregon Public Universities
- IB Diploma earners: possible scholarship money and other enticements

IB Diploma Requirements



- 24 points minimum on 6 subjects
- 12 points minimum total on 3 HL subjects
- Bonus points available for ToK and EE
- Successful completion of CAS
- Must pass ToK, EE, and CAS

How are IB scores calculated?



- Internal assessments (IA) by teacher
- External assessment (EA) by IB
- Each subject has its own % total
- Students MUST complete IA on time
- IA & EA scores are moderated by IB
- Scores are on a 1-7 scale
- Examiners are worldwide

Fees



- Per subject fee: \$119 - \$25 (covered by ODE) = \$94
- Late fees apply to changes after November 15, 2019
- Non-refundable after November 15
- Students approved for Free or Reduced lunch do not pay for exams. Exam costs are covered by the State of Oregon Dept. of Education.

Registration



- IB Exam Registration ends **OCTOBER 31, 2019**
- Exam registration information can be found in an announcement on Canvas MHS Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses
 - Online registration form
 - Paper signature form
 - SUBMIT the signature form with PROOF OF PAYMENT, at the IB OFFICE (214A) by **OCTOBER 31, 2019**

How to Pay



- Make **CHECKS** payable to Mountainside HS, submit to Bookkeeper and get a receipt of payment.

OR

- **PAY ONLINE:** <https://or-beaverton.intouchreceipting.com/>
 - When accessing the online system, after choosing the student, choose “school items” to find the IB Exams tab
 - You will need to select each exam for payment
 - The \$6 postage is a **one-time** fee

Testing Procedures



- All exams are on-site at Mountainside HS.
- May 1 – May 22, 2020 (exam schedule is published on IB page of MHS website; times TBD).
- IB exams may conflict with District or State athletic competitions or similar events. Regardless, IB exams cannot be rescheduled for any reason.
- Results available electronically in July, 2020; access credentials will be provided to students after exams.
