

**DRESS AND GROOMING REGULATIONS – HANFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT 2013-14**

<b>Garment Type</b>	<b>Requirements</b>	<b>Examples of Prohibited Apparel</b>
<b>Tops</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be worn tucked in and long enough to stay tucked in</li> <li>• Bare stomachs or bare backs may not be exposed</li> <li>• Must conceal undergarments at all times</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Oversized tops</li> <li>• Underwear tops</li> <li>• Sleepwear</li> <li>• Tank tops /tube tops/ sleeveless tops</li> <li>• Tight tops</li> <li>• Swimwear/beach wear</li> <li>• Fishnet/see-through/revealing tops</li> <li>• Bare midriff tops</li> <li>• Low-Cut</li> <li>• Off the shoulder tops/halter tops</li> <li>• Muscle shirts</li> <li>• Spaghetti straps</li> </ul>
<b>Bottoms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must fit properly (no sagging or bagging)</li> <li>• Pants must be hemmed at least one inch off ground and must be no higher than the ankle</li> <li>• Dresses, jumpers, and skirts may not be more than 4 inches above the knee</li> <li>• Shorts and skorts may not be more than 4 inches above the top of the knee or longer than one inch below the knee</li> <li>• Shorts are to be hemmed and not form fitting</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Torn, frayed, or radically altered bottoms</li> <li>• Tight, form fitting pants and shorts</li> <li>• Oversized, saggy, or baggy</li> <li>• Sweat pants style</li> <li>• Sports wear type shorts/pants</li> <li>• Bike shorts (spandex)</li> <li>• Wide leg style</li> <li>• Bottoms with bibs ( no overalls)</li> <li>• Sleepwear</li> <li>• Stapled, taped, pinned, rubber bands, elastic around bottom of pant leg</li> </ul>
<b>Outer Garments</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May not be more than one size too large or one size too small</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hoods allowed but may only be worn outside in inclement weather</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes must be worn at all times</li> <li>• Closures must be properly secured</li> <li>• Closed toe and heel</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes with cleats</li> <li>• High heels</li> <li>• Sandals</li> <li>• Shoes with rollers</li> <li>• Military style or steel toed boots</li> <li>• Backless shoes</li> <li>• Slippers</li> <li>• Thongs</li> </ul>
<b>Belts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• May not hang down</li> <li>• Must be worn through belt loops</li> </ul>	
<b>Headwear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hats may be worn outside during inclement weather or for sun protection. Sun protection hats must have a 2 inch brim all the way around.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hats , caps, visors</li> <li>• Sweatbands and head bands (except for participants in sporting events)</li> <li>• "Do-rags" and bandannas</li> </ul>
<b>Jewelry/ Tatoos</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Earrings must be small and worn in the ears</li> <li>• No visible tatoos</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Body piercing (eyebrows, nose, lips, tongue, etc.) Ear Plugs, visible tatoos</li> </ul>

\*\*Also Refer to your individual school site policy for prohibited gang apparel

**Consequences for Dress Code Violations:**

- First Violation: Home contact; student may be sent home to change clothing, hairstyle, or cosmetic
- Second Violation: Home contact; student may be sent home to change; student shall be issued a Level A Citation for willful disobedience
- Third Violation: Student shall be issued a Level B Citation for Defiance of Authority
