PJA Afterschool Department Homework Support

(Please read carefully and complete back portion before returning)

Homework support is an important part of the PJA Afterschool day. Monday through Thursday afternoon, our programs provide at least 30 minutes of supervised space and time for children to read quietly and/or work towards completing homework assignments. All PJA Afterschool programs are equipped with the tools needed to support children in their reading and homework completion.

As choice-based programs, whether or not children choose to take advantage of this time is entirely up to them. However, families who wish to make homework a priority can complete a **Homework Contract** with their child.

Homework Contract specifies:

- What days of the week the child should be taking advantage of homework
- How homework time will be used (e.g. reading only, homework only, both)
- How much time the child should spend taking advantage of homework time

The Role of Afterschool Staff in the Homework Contract

Our Afterschool teaching staff will remind children about homework time and support them in finding a comfortable space in the homework time area. Please note: Staff will not go through a child/youth's backpack to look for their homework. Children can expect to receive general assistance from our Afterschool teaching staff as well as support in accessing homework-related resources. Due to strict licensing regulations staff are not able to provide one-on-one assistance or tutoring.

Homework Incentives

PJA Afterschool believes that it is important to celebrate and reward each student's homework efforts. For every 30 minutes a child spends reading or working on homework, we give them one Homework Buck. Children can save their earned Homework Bucks until it's time to spend them at the Homework Store. These incentives are offered to all children who work on their homework, whether they have a Homework Contact or freely come to work on homework or enjoy a book.

Homework Store provides an opportunity for children to learn about and practice money management and math skills on both a personal and business level. Items available to purchase in the Homework Store vary widely and we strive to make the experience fun and educational. In addition to the extrinsic motivation our Homework Store and Homework Bucks encourage, we feel that the whole homework experience promotes intrinsic motivation as well. Students find homework time to be an enjoyable experience where they gain confidence in themselves and their abilities, learn how to hold themselves accountable and feel excited about their accomplishments.
