243 CAMPUS PRIVILEGES

Statement of Policy

As students progress through high school, they should be granted increased opportunities to develop self-discipline by choosing how to use their non-instructional time, as long as such use does not interfere with the operation of the school. "Non-instructional time" refers to time when a student is not scheduled for a class but may be assigned to a study hall. This policy authorizes qualified students to select alternatives to study hall assignment for their non-instructional time on a graduated schedule.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall promulgate regulations implementing this policy which shall provide for the following:

1. Designation of areas for use by students during their non-instructional time.
2. Appropriate procedures for supervising student conduct on the campus.
3. Minimum assignments to class time.
4. Parental consent for student participation.
5. Eligibility based on grade level, academic achievement and student conduct.
