ACADEMICS AND SCHOOL LIFE

Academics

FASNY students earn either the French Baccalaureate or International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, in addition to a New York State high school diploma. In both diploma programs, students can earn a bilingual diploma in French and English. FASNY is the only school in the tri-state area to offer both the International Baccalaureate and French Baccalaureate. Typically, about 50% of FASNY students matriculate at universities in the United States, 25% at universities in Canada, and 25% at universities in the United Kingdom and Europe.

Grading

FASNY uses the French 0-20 grading scale, which is converted to U.S.-style letter grades as follows:

A+=15-20; A=14; A-=13; B+=12; B=11; B-=10; C+=9; C=8; C-=7; D+=6; D=5; D-=4; F=3

Given our diversity of programs and assessments, we do not rank our students or calculate overall GPA. For each school year, students with an average over 12.5 receive an Honors designation. Students with an average over 14 are awarded a High Honors designation. Students with an average of 16 and above are awarded Highest Honors.

High School Life

Strong arts, music, athletics, clubs, and community service programs, combined with national and international educational trips, contribute to a well-rounded and enriching school experience. Students study Shakespeare in London and U.S. history in Washington, DC. They have opportunities to pursue service learning in countries such as Nicaragua and the Dominican Republic, cultural exchange programs in Bolivia and Germany, and/or a trimester-long exchange with a school in Alicante, Spain. All students are required to complete 50 hours of community service, and many choose to exceed this expectation.

BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMS

The International Baccalaureate

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) is a challenging and innovative course of study recognized worldwide. Its mission is to “develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.” FASNY began offering students the IBDP in the 2015-2016 school year, with the first cohort of IB students graduating in 2017. Almost all FASNY students graduate with a bilingual IB diploma.

The French Baccalaureate

The French Baccalaureate is a rigorous academic curriculum established by the French Ministry of National Education, with both written and oral examinations at the completion of grades 11 and 12. FASNY students choose between two Bac concentrations: Economics and Social Sciences (ES) or Sciences and Mathematics (S). Students with exceptionally strong English may choose to pursue the International Option (OIB) of the French Bac, which entails high-level study of Literature, History, and Geography in English.
