When to keep your child home from school

- A temperature of 100 or over is a sure sign to keep your child home. Child must be 24 hours fever free without fever reducing medication before returning to school. Refrain from giving child a fever reducer and sending them to school as it will wear off, as well as expose other children to sickness
- 2. If your child has been vomiting or has diarrhea during the previous evening, please keep child home
- 3. Any undiagnosed Rash
- 4. Keep your child home if they have heavy nasal congestion and or frequent cough. Children feel miserable and will likely not focus on school, disrupt class, and share his/her virus with classmates
- 5. If your child is diagnosed with a contagious disease, such as strep, they should be on antiobiotics for 24 hours before returning to school
- If your child has crusty, red or weepy eyes with thick or sticky eye
 drainage please keep them at home until evaluated by a medical
 provider. Prescription medication may be needed depending on
 the diagnosis

Be sure that the school has current telephone numbers to reach you at all time in case your child becomes ill or injured. School is important, but sick children need to stay at home!
