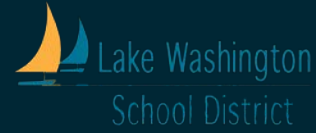

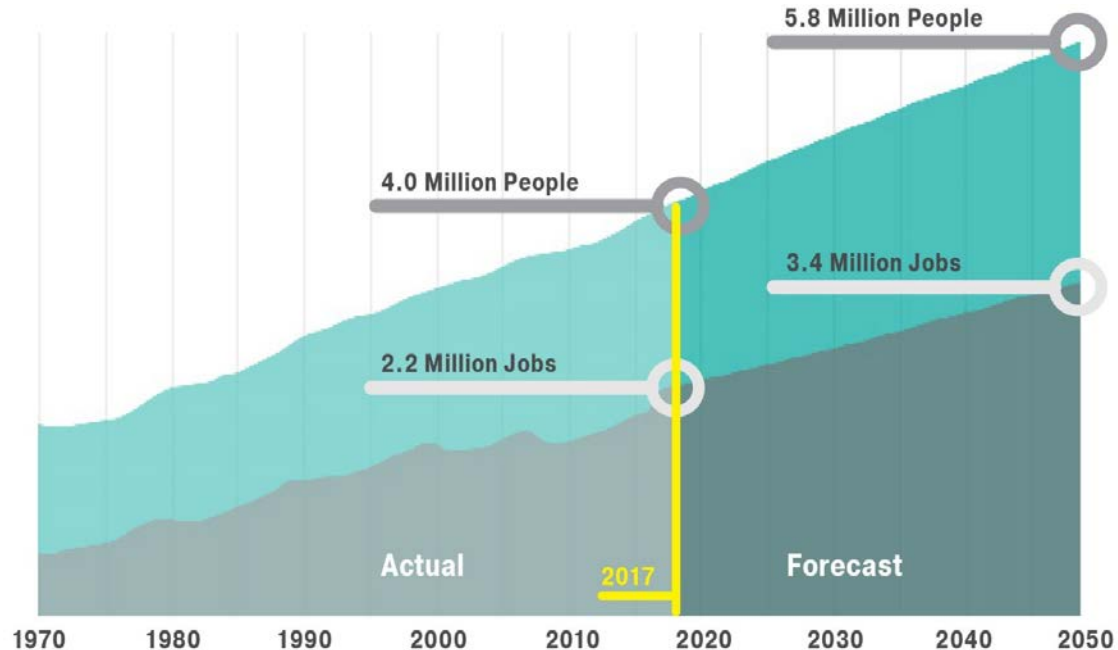

The long-range forecast is for continued growth

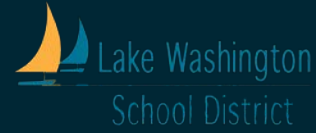
- The region is projected to grow by about **1.8 million people** between 2017 and 2050
- The region is projected to add about **1.2 million jobs** between 2017 and 2050



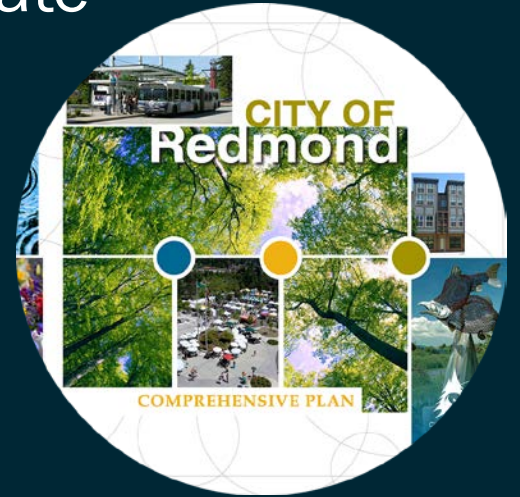
Process: Setting targets

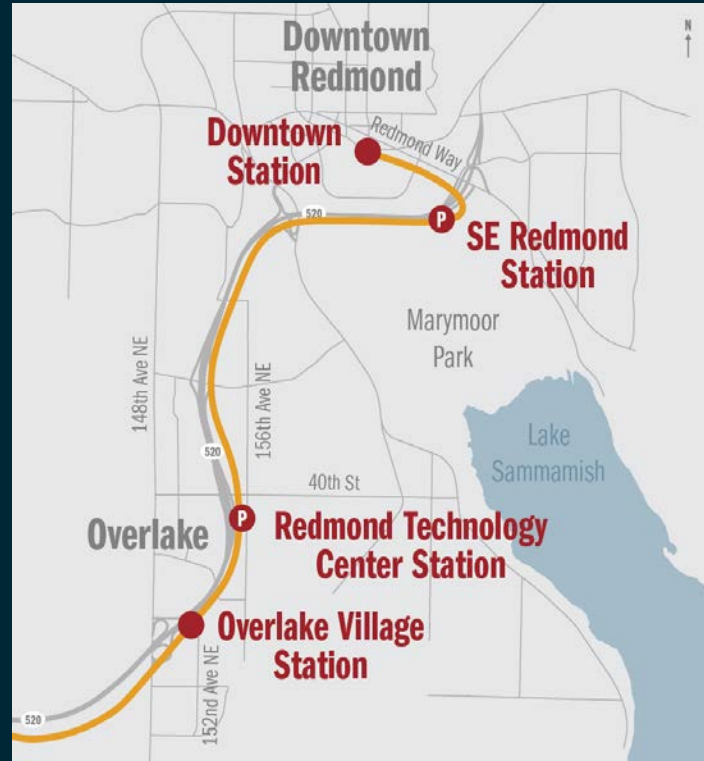
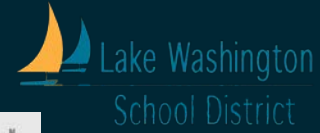

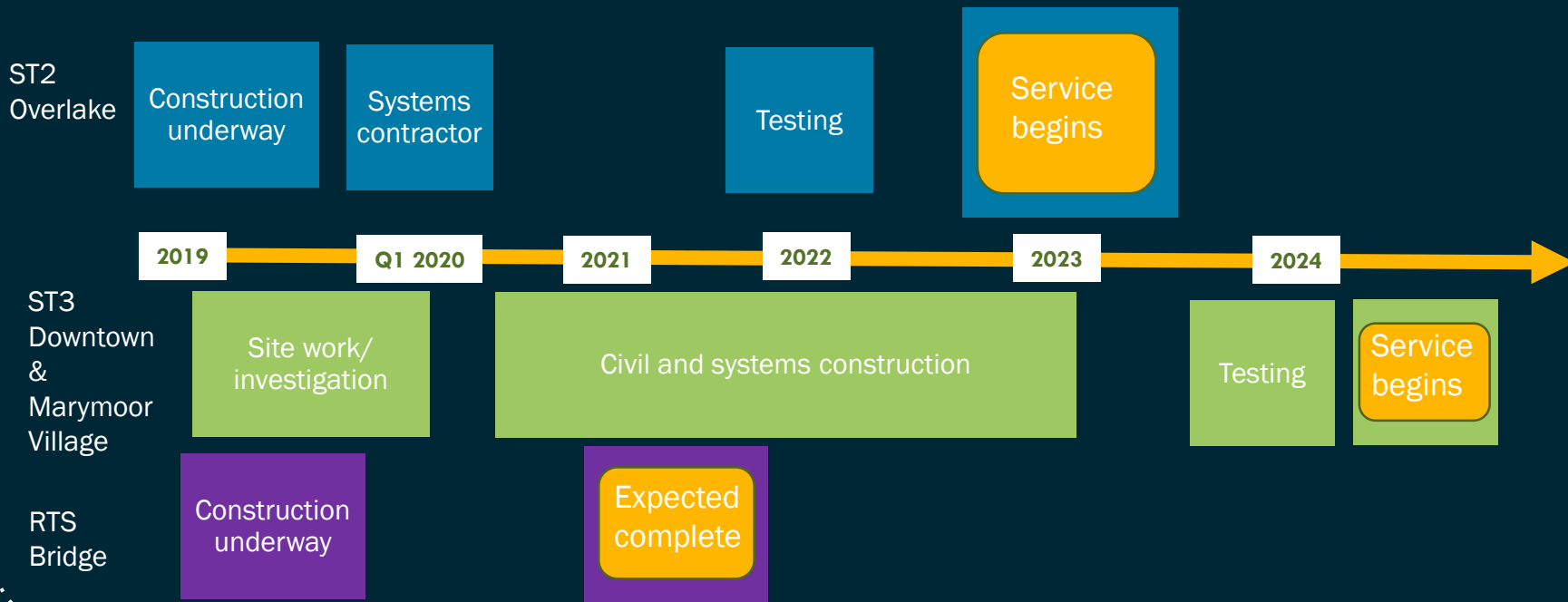
- Light Rail in Redmond

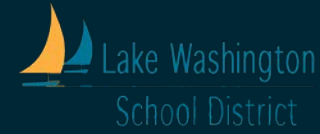
Capital Project Planning: Field Use

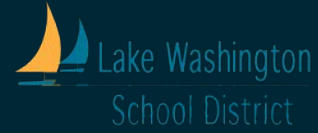
