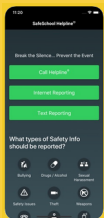


SAFE SCHOOL HELPLINE

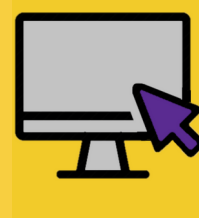

- *Call with concerns about safety/well-being of student, acts of bullying or violence, theft, drug or alcohol use, or harassment.*
- *Live, trained mental health counselor available 24 hours a day/7 days a week/365 days of year to support students feeling depressed or suicidal.*
