

# Concert Make up Assignment

In the case that you are not able to attend the choir concert, and have turned in an excuse note, below you will find the form with instructions on how to make up the concert. Concerts are considered Major Test Grades since they are the culmination of usually 6-8 weeks or in class rehearsals.

## Guidelines:

1. If no project is turned in, a "0" will be entered for that performance.
2. All make-up projects should be good enough to be displayed in the choir room or on the choir website. Students should be sure that their writing is in their own words and is edited for sentence structure, punctuation and spelling. Plagiarism will result in an automatic failure.

**A student missing a performance should complete one of the following projects below:**

Create a tag board poster, OR 2-page paper, OR electronic presentation with pictures and text (An 8 slide PowerPoint, Prezi, etc) about either an artist of your choosing or a report on a musical event you have attended in within the last four months. (Must be a music concert).
