Seniors should have scheduled their portrait photography session during the summer or early fall but there is certainly still time to get that done. All portraits must be submitted by you or your photographer of choice by the end of December. This will be the photo used on their “Senior Page”.

Portraits submitted from sources other than Frausini Photography need to be of high quality, and 2 ¼ inches by 3 ¼ inches. If submitted digitally (email to raitia@region18.org), photos should still be this size and a minimum of 3.5 megapixels. They should be .jpg format and titled with last and first name of student. Portraits are required to be submitted by December 18, 2019.
