- On site supervision for any support for social emotional learning staff, hired or volunteer.
- Establishes and facilitates Care Team/Student Study Team meetings for higher risk students to include teachers, resource personnel and administration. (If this position already exists, then substitute "Participates" for "Establishes and facilitates."
- Develops relationships with community-based organizations to provide onsite specialized services.
 Evaluates merits of these services.
- Seeks professional development opportunities for staff.

- Develops a SEL curriculum for the LFSF.
- Organizes information sessions for parents, staff and students.
