- Please remember the following guidelines when considering a costume for your student: costumes must be age appropriate, no scary masks, no fake blood, no weapons and no make-up. They should be school appropriate (no sleeveless tops, no exposed stomachs, etc.) Costumes should also be easy for students to put on independently.
- If you have signed-up either to work a classroom party or send in supplies, please refer to the information provided by your classroom party coordinator regarding guidelines for snacks etc. Please note, no bakery items are allowed, and snacks must be prepackaged and individually wrapped. Also, please contact your child's classroom teacher regarding any allergies.
- To maintain security, there will be NO ADULT COSTUMES ALLOWED for visitor party volunteers.
