



Navigating Your Time in Concurrent Enrollment at Weber State University

1. Apply for Admission

- Visit the Admissions page at weber.edu/concurrent for detailed instructions. PLEASE NOTE: *Completing the application does not register you for classes, rather makes you eligible to register.*
- Submit online application; be sure to select the CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT application
- Pay \$30 application fee

2. Get your WSU user name and password

- 24-48 hours after being admitted you will be able to set-up your WSU user name and password.
- Go to <https://portalapps.weber.edu/getwcid/>
- Enter your date of birth and social security number
- Take note of your user name and *temporary password*
- Click continue to change your password to something you can remember

3. Complete Orientation for New Concurrent Enrollment Students

- Log-in to your eWeber Portal
- Search for “New Student Orientation”
- Complete the module for Concurrent Enrollment students

4. Register for classes

- Follow the instructions provided by your high school concurrent enrollment course instructor to register for each of your CE courses.

5. Pay for classes

For students who are pursuing the General Education Certificate of Completion or the Associate Degree in General Studies only:

6. Meet with your High School Counselor to discuss educational goals.

- During this appointment you will discuss if pursuing a degree through Concurrent Enrollment is a good fit for you.
- During this meeting your high school counselor will complete the High School Counselor Degree Seeking Agreement

7. Meet with a WSU Concurrent Enrollment Advisor AFTER completing Orientation and meeting with your high school counselor.

During this appointment you will review degree options with a WSU CE advisor and develop a plan for completion.

- Email ceadvising@weber.edu to schedule your appointment. Most appointments will be held at WSU’s Davis Campus in Layton.
- Be sure to bring your planned courses with you to this meeting so that we can best advise you on the courses needed to complete the degree you choose.

During your Senior Year:

- Complete the Status Switch through your eWeber Portal no later than **DECEMBER 1**
- Complete the Weber State University Specialized Scholarship Application to be considered for awards in addition to any academic award you may qualify for. You will complete this in your eWeber Portal
- Watch your Weber State student email for notification that it is time to apply for graduation from WSU. You will apply through eWeber Portal
