1. **Welcome:** In attendance we have Mrs. Lundell, Mrs. James, Mrs. Pope, Karen Peterson, Janae Howell, Erica Polley, and Amanda Mitchell.
2. **Review of Minutes:** Mrs. James reviewed the notes from Sept. 25, 2019
3. **School Improvement Plan:** The Council participated in a training video produced by the state to review roles and responsibilities of Community council members.
4. **School Business:** We needed to select a vice-chair for the Community Council and that will be Mrs. Pope. We looked over testing stats for Summative Math 2016-2019. We had generally been trending upward, but with the new testing platform, we dropped and missed making our 38% proficiency goal by 1% for grades 3-6. In reviewing our reading Dibels data, we did make our goal last year and had 71% of our K-3 students reading with typical/better progress. We also discussed the year 2 of 3 purchases just recently made for audio enhancement systems in the school. We are prioritizing classrooms 1st and leaving the non-classroom spaces for the year 3 purchases.

Our next meeting will be on January 22, 2020. We were asked to be thinking, considering, and gathering input for next year's School Improvement Plan/goals in the meanwhile. The administration plans to survey staff members for their input as well, and suggestions were made to inform survey takers of the possibilities for Trustlands funding and what it may/may not be used for and also to gather input on their priorities for professional development options that would best benefit students and staff...A suggestion was made that we possibly may want to do more investigation on the district initiatives with SEL, and including that in next year's funding, as well. Mrs. James will prepare and send out that survey.
