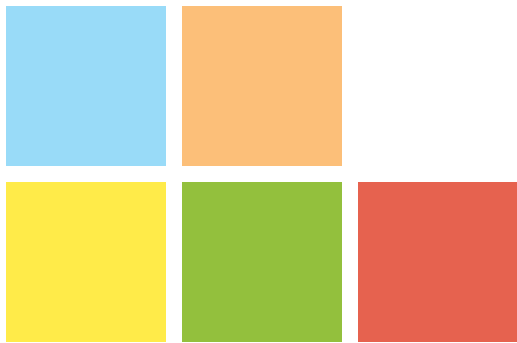

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## Elementary Arrivals and Dismissals

### When can my child come to school?

WCA provides early morning supervision beginning at 7:30 am in the cafeteria area. The Academy does not provide supervision before 7:30 a.m. If such a need exists, please contact our Early Education director, Mrs. Emily Orman. Students arriving to school between 7:30 a.m. and 8 a.m. must report to the cafeteria area (unless parents remain with child). Students arriving after 8 am should go directly to their classrooms. Students are considered tardy when arriving to the classroom after 8:10 a.m.

### When can I pick up my child?

Dismissal for Elementary students begins at 2:30 p.m. Unless your child is scheduled for the After School Program, he/she will need to be picked up no later than 2:45 pm. All students who remain after 2:45 pm become a part of our After School Program and parents are then charged for this service.

### Where should I pick up my child?

Children should be picked up as denoted below. However, it should be noted that all Elementary students who ride with a younger sibling or friend must report to the youngest child's pickup spot.

K1 & K2 -	Canopy A (Centennial)
1st Grade -	Canopy B (Centennial)
2nd Grade -	Connector (Auditorium)
3rd Grade -	MS Gym (Eastchester)
4th Grade -	MS Gym (Eastchester)

### Please help us on the Eastchester side!

If you are picking up your child on the Eastchester side, we need you to help us avoid traffic backup problems

on Eastchester Drive. Please use the far West entrance on Centennial and proceed through the parking lot to the Eastchester dismissal area (D). This will enable any backups to be accommodated in our parking lot area rather than on Eastchester. Thank you for your help!

### Safety Issues on Eastchester side...

Parents who enter on the Eastchester side and choose to park in that area may walk to the sidewalk and personally cross these lanes with their children. Children will not be dismissed to the parking area, but parents may continue to cross with them. Once your child is with you in your vehicle, he or she should not get out of the car to walk around or return to the school without the personal escort of the parent. Thank you for your assistance with these important safety issues.

### Nurse Notes
