## SCHOOL PROFILE 2019-2020

**Bear Creek High School** is one of four comprehensive, four-year high schools in the Lodi Unified School District. Located in North Stockton, Bear Creek is 50 miles south of Sacramento, the state capital and 90 miles east of San Francisco.

Classroom programs are supplemented by a wide range of co-curricular experiences for students. Students are challenged by a strong academic curriculum with opportunities in the arts, sciences, math, graphics, social sciences, journalism, languages, and speech. Bear Creek High offers 16 Advanced Placement courses as well as 5 Pre-AP/Honors courses. Small learning academies and leadership programs offer a school-within-a-school approach of integrated curriculum in two subject areas. Bear Creek High students have access to 18 men's and women's varsity sports, as well as a variety of service and curriculum related clubs. Bear Creek High places a high priority on maintaining a school environment that promotes academics, diversity, respect, self-esteem and safety.

**Accreditation:** Bear Creek High went through an accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges our accreditation is granted through, Spring 2021.

**Enrollment** as of October 2018-2019, is approx. 2,172 students.
