



Merit Scholarships

In addition to need-based financial aid, St. Anselm's offers a limited number of non-need-based merit scholarships.

Merit scholarships are entitled **Headmaster's Scholarships**. They are awarded to a select number of **new** students each year. Criteria may include:

- academic accomplishments
- extra-curricular accomplishments
- demonstrated leadership
- student's grades
- admission test results
- teacher recommendations

Merit scholarships will be offered to those applicants who would be a benefit to the St. Anselm's community. In part, the scholarship is intended to influence the family's choice to attend St. Anselm's.

Merit scholarships do not require an additional application. Students are considered for a merit scholarship from the pool of applicants. We are unable to provide specific qualifications to indicate the likelihood of receiving a merit scholarship. Students who have been awarded a merit scholarship will be notified upon acceptance to St. Anselm's.

Headmaster's Scholarships range in value from \$3,000 to \$4,000 and are primarily intended for high school applicants. Occasionally and in smaller amounts, Headmaster's Scholarships may be offered to middle school applicants.

All merit scholarships are renewed annually, provided the student continues to meet the merit scholarship criteria and school expectations.
