II. School Plan

A. Written Plan

1. The location of Sand Springs Elementary is 242 North 3200 West, Layton, UT 84041.

2. Existing Traffic Controls – There are various stop and yield signs throughout the subdivisions. There are traffic signals at:

3200 West and Gordon Avenue

3200 West and Hill Field

3200 West and Gentile Street

3. Established School Crossings -

3200 West & Gordon Avenue

242 North 3200 West (in front of school)

3200 West and Hill Field

3425 West Gentile

4. Reduced Speed Zone

3200 West (in front of the school)

West Gentile Street between 3425 West and 3475 West

5. Established Narrow School Routes – There are none.

6. Present Access Routes (see attached Map 1).

Area 1 (West Park Village): Students in this area feed the school using 200 East or 100 East to Gordon Avenue and then south on east side of 3200 West to the school.

Area 2 (Windsor Meadows): Students in this area feed the school using Sandi Drive, Brady Way, Jodi Drive, Lindi Way to Gordon Avenue and then south on the east side of 3200 West to the school. Some students live outside the 1.5-mile radius of the school and are eligible bus riders.

Area 3 (Coventry Park and Meadow Green) : Students in this area feed the school using 3450 West, 3575 West, or 3675 West to Gordon Avenue and then south on the east side of 3200 West to the school.

Area 4 (Gordon Avenue and Westfield Estates): Students in this area feed the school using 3700 West or 3500 West to Gordon Avenue and then south on the east side of 3200 West to the school.

Area 5 (Wild Horse Springs and Sierra Bella): Students in this area feed the school using 350 North and then south on 3200 West or 150 North to the school.

Area 6 (Wild Horse Meadows): Students walk east on Hill Field Road or 3650 West and on the south side of 275 North and the south on the west side of 3200 West to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 7 (Sunset Farms): Students in this area feed the school using 575 West to Gentile Street and then north on the west side of 3200 West to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 8 (Rockwell Estates, Sandy Ridge, and Wheatfield): Students in this area feed the school using 150 North and 275 North and then south on the west side of 3200 West to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 9 (Feathering Sands): Students in this area feed the school using 3600 West to Gentile Street and then north on the west side of 3200 West to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 10 (Harmony Bluffs, Island View Park, Kershaw Estates, and the south side of Gentile up to 3200 West): Students in this area feed the school using 600 West or 550 West to Gentile Street. Students cross to the north side of Gentile Street at 3425 West and then north on the west side of 3200 West to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 11 (Destination Homes-Windmill) Students in this area feed the school travelling east on Windmill Way (100 S.) then north on 3200 W., staying on the west side, continuing to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 12. (Layton Shores, Nilson Homes, Perry Homes-Major Estates) Students from Layton Shores and Nilson Homes areas will travel south on 3550 W. to Hill Field Road, travel east to 3200 W. They will travel south on 3200 W. to the crosswalk west of the school. They could also travel east on 650 N. to 3200 W. and take the same route to Sand Springs Elementary. Students from Perry Homes-Major Estates will travel from 2550 W. to 1000 N. Then they will travel south on 3200 W. to the crosswalk west of the school.

Area 13 (Out of Boundary): Students live outside the boundary of Sand Springs Elementary. These students are participating in the Spanish Immersion program or have received boundary variances. They feed the school in private transportation.

7. Sidewalks (or lack of) – Recently developed areas have sidewalks. Gordon Avenue has sidewalks to 3200 West. 3200 West has sidewalks on the east side of the road from 150 North to Gordon Avenue. There are partial sidewalks along 3200 West from 150 North to Gentile Street. Gentile Street has sidewalks on the north side to the end of the Layton City border. There are no sidewalks on the south side of Gentile.

8. Bicycle Routes – The bicycle routes will be the same as the walking routes. Students will ride their bikes on

the road as far to the right as possible, allowing vehicle traffic the right of way.

9. Future Growth Areas – Growth areas have been indicated on Map 3. With the growth of Layton, Syracuse and Clearfield being so rapid, we are anticipating many new homes in the future.

10. Bus Loading/Unloading Areas – There is a bus loading/unloading driveway on the south side of the school accessed from 150 North or 3100 West (see attached Map 2).

11. Other Vehicle Loading/Unloading Areas – There is a parent loading/unloading driveway on the west side of the school accessed from 3200 West (see attached Map 2). Parents also unload students on 150 North. Students unloaded on the south side of 150 North, use the crosswalk at 150 North and 3100 West.

B. Dissemination of Plan and Training

1. After the plan has been approved, the plan summary will be made available in the school office for parents.

2. All elementary school children shall be given training on the routing plan, on crossing safety, and bike safety in the fall of each school year.
