## **Emergency Preparedness Plan**

- Review of Standard Response Protocol.
- Review of SafeUT and See Something/Say Something.
- Daily Safety Announcements.
- Highlight Hope Squads and other school intervention Programs.
- Water in Portables and update buckets with suckers and bandages.

## **Safe Childhood Access Routing Plan**

- Monitor Traffic to become one way (not a city change but education to parents), parent pickup worse than drop off. Possible Adult monitors at traffic areas.
- Change at the Elementary Crosswalk that is accessed by junior high students.
- Train students not to dart out in front of cars.

## **Secure Entry and School Safety discussion including the following:**

- Secure vestibule and doors-visitors must be buzzed in by office after showing ID.
- Students in halls during class with hall passes only.
- Emergency buckets and folders in each teacher's classroom.

- Safe school presentations during the first two weeks of school.
- Monthly drills.
- Administrative and faculty supervision before and after school, during passing periods, and at lunch.
- Faculty and staff wear badges.
- Visitor badges.
