

ITEM #1: SNAP map showing crossing-guards, stop signs, pedestrian crossing, bus loading/unloading, sidewalks, bus routes, school boundaries, and student walking paths.

SCHOOL PLAN:

Existing Traffic Controls:

There are various stop, yield, school crossing, and speed zone signs throughout the subdivisions that are access routes for children attending Buffalo Point Elementary School. These major controls are shown on the map.

Proposed School Crossings:

There are crossing guards to assist children in three locations (See SNAP map).

- 1- At the intersection of 3000 W and Antelope Drive for children to cross east and west across 3000 W.
- 2- At the intersection of Antelope Drive and Doral Drive.
- 3- At the corner of the school property on 1840 S for students to cross to and from the school property.
- 4- At the corner of 1850 S for students to cross east and west over Doral Drive.
- 5- Reduced school speed zone associated with the crosswalk at Doral Drive and State Road 127 (Antelope Dr.)

Bus Loading and Unloading:

Buses are to load and unload east of the building in the bus zone with access off Doral Drive. Day Care vans have access to bus zone, but area is closed to regular traffic.

Regular Traffic:

Regular traffic should follow all traffic rules when conducting pick-up and drop-off curb side in the drive-through directly in front of the building. Traffic will flow from the north to the south in the pick-up and drop-off area. Parents will be encouraged to drop-off and pick-up in alternative safe areas within the surrounding school block where students can walk without crossing a street.

Bicycle Routes:

Bicycle routes will be the same as walking routes.

Preferred Walking Routes:

Area 1: Area directly to the east and south of Buffalo Point Elementary - Students will follow the shortest route they choose. Those students to the south will walk on sidewalks on the side of the streets to 3400 W. Those students living to the east will walk on sidewalks on the side of the streets to either 2050 S or 1850 S, whichever is closer to their houses. 2050 S and 1850 S funnel to 3300 west. At Doral Drive, students will cross, in the crosswalk, to/from school grounds.

Area 2: Students will walk to 1840 S then east to the school grounds.

Area 3: North section of the Freemont Estates - Students will walk west on sidewalks to 3000 W. At 3000 W, students will walk on the sidewalk on the east side of the road north to Antelope Drive (1700 S). At Antelope Drive, students will cross 3000 W with a crossing guard. Students will continue walking on the sidewalk on the south side of Antelope Drive to 3300 W. At 3300 W, students will turn south into the Ranchette's subdivision and will walk south on the sidewalks to 1850 S. 1850 S travels to 3400 W. From 3400 W all students will walk west on the sidewalks through the neighborhood to Doral Drive. At Doral Drive student will cross Doral Drive in the crosswalk to the school grounds. It may be possible for students in this area to walk back to the bus stops to the south in the eligible area.

Area 4: South section of Freemont Estates - This is a bus eligible area. Students will ride the bus to and from school.

Area 5: Area including all the homes by Glen Eagle in the big block surrounded by Antelope to the south, 4000 W to the west, and 3000 W to the east and just North of Jupiter Hills Drive - All students will walk on sidewalks to Doral Drive. After reaching Doral Drive, students will walk south on the sidewalk on the east side of Doral Drive to Antelope Drive. Students will cross south across Antelope Drive with the crossing guard. Students will then continue on Doral Drive to 1840 S where they will cross 1840 S with a crossing guard onto the school property.

Area 6: Area in the northeast of the big block -- This is a bus eligible area. Students will ride the bus to and from school.

Area 7: Area west of 4000 W and south of 1200 S, also known as Bridgeway Island Development - Students will walk on sidewalks to 1315 S. Students will then continue east on 1315 S to 4000 W on the sidewalk on the south side of 1315 S. At 4000 W, students will cross the road in the painted crosswalk to Hammon Lane (1320 S) where they will continue east on Hammon Lane to Doral Drive. After reaching Doral Drive, students will walk south on the sidewalk on the east side of Doral Drive to Antelope Drive. Students will cross south across Antelope Drive with a crossing guard. Students will then continue on Doral Drive to 1840 S where they will cross 1840 S with a crossing guard onto the school property

Area 8: Area that includes south of 1550 S. and both sides of 4500 W. Students will walk south on 4500 on the wide area of shoulder on the east side of 4500 W to Antelope Drive. Students coming from Simpson Springs subdivision can walk on the sidewalk until it ends on the west side of the road, then proceed on the shoulder until crossing to the next sidewalk at the corner of Antelope Drive and 4500 W. At Antelope Drive, students will walk east on the sidewalk on the north side of Antelope Drive to Doral Drive. After reaching Doral Drive, students will walk south on the sidewalk on the east side of Doral Drive to Antelope Drive. Students will cross south across Antelope Drive with a crossing guard. Students will then continue on Doral Drive to 1840 S where they will cross 1840 S with a crossing guard onto the school property.

Current Construction:

There are several building projects underway within Buffalo Point boundaries.

- Criddle Farms (4000W)

- Greyson Ridge (Doral)
- Construction South of BPE along Doral Drive to 2700 S.
- Simpson Spring (4500 W)

Recommendations:

Buffalo Point Elementary is recommending that Syracuse City look at installing a sidewalk to the evacuation site. Currently Buffalo Point will evacuate to Glen Eagle Club House if need arises and there is no sidewalk on the north side of Antelope Drive. Additional sidewalk is needed along Doral Drive from approximately 1925 S. to 2200 S. where Doral Drive is newly connected. Extending the sidewalk south along 4500 W. from the LDS church building to Antelope Drive is also recommended for safe student passage. Painting a crosswalk running East and West on the intersection of 4500 W. and Antelope Drive is also recommended.

With construction taking place throughout neighborhoods that feed into Buffalo Point, we are asking for as much advanced notice when road closures will be affecting.
