

Drew Charter School's CCRPI Scores Significantly Exceed State and District Averages

The Georgia Department of Education released the 2019 College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) scores today, a comprehensive 0-100 score that measures a school's academic achievement and growth, along with other school factors. Drew's scores exceeded the state and district averages for all academies.

Academy highlights include:

All Academies

• Earned 4 of 5 stars for the annual school climate rating

Senior Academy

- Significant increase in career pathway completers
- Met all subgroup targets for social studies (US History and Economics)

Junior Academy

- Scores increased in Content Mastery, Closing the Gap and Readiness categories from 2018
- Earned the 2nd highest Readiness score in the district, which measures literacy, attendance and arts participation

Elementary Academy

- Earned the 2nd highest CCRPI score in the district
- Moved up from the 92nd percentile in the state (2018) to the 97th percentile (2019)!
- Only elementary school within Atlanta Public Schools to earn 100 points for the growth category
