The Upper School Nurse will act as a leader in the school community who oversees all school health policies and programs. The Nurse will provide expertise and oversight of school health services and to promote health education.

Using their clinical knowledge and judgment, school nurses routinely perform the following duties:

- Provide healthcare to students and staff
- Perform health screenings
- Coordinate referrals to private healthcare providers
- Serve as liaisons between school personnel, family, and community healthcare providers to ensure a healthy school environment

Job Responsibilities:

- Develop plans for student care based on assessment, interventions, and identification of outcomes, and the evaluation of care
- Serve as a consultant with other school professionals, such as food service personnel, physical education teachers, coaches, and counselors
- Provide health-related education to students, staff and parents in both individual and group settings
- Monitor immunizations, manage communicable diseases, and assess the school environment as to prevent injury and ensure safety
- Oversee infection control measures
- Actively participate in school safety plans that address school violence, bullying, and emergencies that may occur at school
- Oversee medication administration, health care procedures, and the development of healthcare plans
- Oversee vision, hearing, body mass index, and mental health screening procedures
- Manage students with chronic health conditions and disabilities
- Make decisions related to the delegation of healthcare tasks as directed by state laws and professional practice guidance
- Manage a staff of two Medical Assistants

Job Requirements:

- Current FL RN license
- BSN required
- Current CPR and First Aid Certification
- 3+ years experience required, preferably in a school or pediatric setting
- Ability to assess situations and act quickly
- Communicate appropriately, collaboratively, and effectively with students, parents, administrators, other school personnel, health care providers, and community agencies.
- Demonstrate a genuine interest in the student population and its health needs.
- Organize a health office and manage time.
- Be a self-starter or self-motivated.
- Proficiency with computers and various software applications.
