## SUBMISSION

All proposals should be submitted via e-mail to the head of school by **Wednesday, Dec. 4**

## WHAT

Based on the ever-popular Shark Tank television show, Knight Tank is an opportunity for a team of teachers and students to submit a proposal to fund a new program, event, class or curriculum at Charlotte Christian School.

## WHO

Each proposal must include at least one student and at least one faculty member or coach. Knight Tank is designed to facilitate collaboration between adults and students. The adult(s) and student(s) can be from different divisions and/or departments. The principal/director of the division who is impacted by the Knight Tank idea must give prior approval before the idea is submitted.

## WHY

Charlotte Christian desires for teachers and students to take ownership of the school's growth and pursue areas that they believe will enhance the educational experience for the student body. We want to focus on programs that develop the four C's of a 21st century learner: critical thinking, collaboration, creativity, and communication.

## PROPOSALS

Proposals must be submitted in written form and should not exceed one page. Each proposal should highlight a new, innovative program that will add value to the CCS experience. Finalists will be asked to make an oral presentation to the review team. The oral presentation can include technology, must include at least one student, and be no more than 15 minutes in length.

Initial proposals should include:

- explanation of opportunity
- summary of the new program
- scope of those involved
- how the funds will be utilized with a simple budget
- the budget may include a stipend for adult leadership
- potential for the program to continue after the initial year and possibly grow in subsequent years

## FUNDS

Proposals should not exceed a budget of \$3,000. A review team including the head of school, the chief financial officer, a member of the board of trustees and one student, will review the proposals and awards/funds not to exceed \$3,000. The potential exists for multiple awards to be given.
