One example of this was a trio of engineers who created an automated solution using robotics that had reduced the number of employees needed to complete a series of tasks from 150 to 2. The investments this company is making are not centered around the assembly line or logistics, but in creating an inclusive workspace that inspires personal excellence and creative thinking...sound familiar?

What I witnessed made even more clear to me that the kind of learning we value at NIS is absolutely essential to the success of our students, both now and into the future. ### Safety Reminder and Appeal

In the last couple of weeks I have received notes of concern from parents, including members of the PTA, about road safety in our neighbourhood. We continue to work with the authorities to take some action about the traffic around the school. I have personally raised this point with the Mayor of QiXia District. There are however four points I would like to bring to your attention.

- 1. Vehicles have the right to turn even if the green crossing light is on, however they are supposed to give way to pedestrians. Many don't so caution is needed.
- 2. Only children over the age of 12 are supposed to ride bicycles on public roads and cycle ways. NIS does not place restrictions on the age of cyclists from our community coming on campus.
- 3. Many of parents still park their motorised bikes off campus to avoids wearing helmets for themselves and their children.
- 4. The most common reason that a student or adult is in need of some form of medical treatment due to an accident is when riding a bicycle off campus. I know of two adults this week alone. Fortunately, both were minor, but could have been worse.

NIS can only remind parents that it is their responsibilities to look after their children's safety off campus. I sometimes feel that my safety messages in assemblies or in the bulletin are met with long sighs. It just seems so simple to me but clearly this is viewed as a matter of personal choice by many of you. Be safe, be well.






- 1. Login Veracross Portal: <a href="http://portals.veracross.com/nis">http://portals.veracross.com/nis</a>

### **Exit Procedure**

- 1. Let us have the name of your child or children, their current grades as well as your expected leaving date.
- Collect a clearance form from Reception, or download off the website.
- 3. Clearance forms need to be completed for each leaving student.
- 4. On the last day of school documents will only be handed over if we have received your completed clearance form.
