지난주에 저는 장쑤성에 새롭게 가동을 시작한 조립공장을 방문할 기 회가 있었습니다. 아마도 이번 방문의 가장 흥미로운 부분은 제품 조 립에서부터 주문 이행까지 고객의 우려를 말끔이 해소하고 심지어 바 닥 청소까지, 작업장 전반에 활용된 자동화 및 인공지능의 사용 범위 일것입니다. 이것의 한 예로 로봇을 사용하는 자동화 솔루션을 개발 해낸 엔지니어 세명이 있었는데 이들은 업무를 이행하는데 필요한 공 장 근로자의 수를 150명에서 2명으로 줄였다고 합니다. 이 회사가 하 고 있는 투자는 어셈블리 라인이나 물류에 집중하는 것이 아니라 개 인 역량의우수성이나 창의적 사고를 고무시키는 포괄적 업무공간을 창조하는 것에 집중한다고 합니다. 매주 보는 소식지에서 많이 듣던 단어들이 아니실런지요?

제가 목격한 것은 NIS가 추구하는 학습이 현재와 미래의 우리 학생들 의 성공에 절대적인 필수 요소라는 것을 더욱 분명하게 해주었습니다 . 인재 육성, 협동적 학습 환경 조성,창의적 문제해결 능력 양성, 비정 규 과제에 중점을 두는 것은 NIS와 세계의 고등교육기관 어디서나 우 선으로 두는 과제입니다. 업무의 본질이 변화되었고 앞으로도 계속 변화할 것입니다. 저는 미래의 변화에 대처하기위해 매일 함께 노력 하는 우리 커뮤너티의 일원이라는 점이 매우 자랑스럽니다.

- 2. 只有12周岁以上的儿童可以在公共道路的自行车道上骑车。NIS并 没有限制自行车的骑行年龄。
- 很多家长任然在校园意外的地方停放摩托车,以逃避给自己和孩子带头盔。
- 学生或成年人发生需要就医的事故,最常见的原因是骑自行车。 一周之内我认识的人里就有两个成年人发生了事故。但是幸运的 是,事故并不严重,否则可能面临更糟糕的结果。

NIS只能提醒家长们,照顾孩子们在校园以外地方的安全是家长们自己的责任。有时候,我觉得我在会议或每周公告中发布的安全信息没有引起反响。对我来说这看起来十分简单,但是毫无疑问,许多人将其视为个人的选择问题。请注意安全,保持身体健康。

Safety Reminder and Appeal

지난 몇 주간 저는 몇몇 학부모님들과 PTA측으로부터 우리 주변의 도로 안 전에 관한 우려를 전달받았습니다. 저희는 학교 주변의 교통에 대해 정부 당 국과 함께 꾸준히 조치를 취해오고 있습니다. 저는 취샤치 (栖霞区)지구 시 장에게도 사견을 전달해오고 있습니다. 하지만 네가지 중요한 사항을 여러 분에게도 알려야 할 사안이 있습니다.

1. 차량은 신호등이 초록색이여도 우회전을 할 수 있지만, 보행자가 우선입 니다. 안타깝게도 이 녹색불 일경우 보행자 우선 수칙이 잘 지켜지고 있지 않기에 주의를 요합니다.

2.

12세 이상의 아동일 경우에만 공공도로에서 자전거를 탈 수 있습니다. 그러 나 NIS는 캠퍼스에 진입하는 우리 커뮤너티에게 연령제한을 따로 두고 있지 는 않습니다.

여전히 많은 학부모님들이 본인과 자녀의 헬멧 착용 규칙을 피하기 위해
 서 학교 밖에 오토바이, 디엔동등을 캠퍼스 밖에 주차를 하고 있습니다.

4. 학생이나 성인이 사고로 치료를 해야하는 가장 흔한 원인은 캠퍼스 밖에 서 자전거를 타는 경우입니다. 안타깝게도 이번 주에만 성인 두명이 경미하 지만 자칫했다간 큰일이 될 수 도 있었던 사고가 있었습니다.

NIS는 학부모님들께 캠퍼스 밖에서 아이들의 안전을 돌보는 것은 여러분의 책임임을 상기시켜드리는 것 외에는 어떠한 권한도 가지고 있지 않습니다. 저는 때때로 어셈블리때나 위클리 소식을 통해서 공지해 드리는 이 안전 수 칙이 간과 당한다는 느낌을 지울 수가 없습니다. 이 사안은 제게는 너무도 간 단해 보이지만 많은 분들이 이를 개인의 선택이라고 여기고 지키지 않는 다 는 점이 매우 안타깝습니다. 사고 예방 차원에서안전 수칙을 잘 지켜주시길 바랍니다.

If I were to sum up this year's ACAMIS Volleyball season in one word, that word would be "resilience." 
