

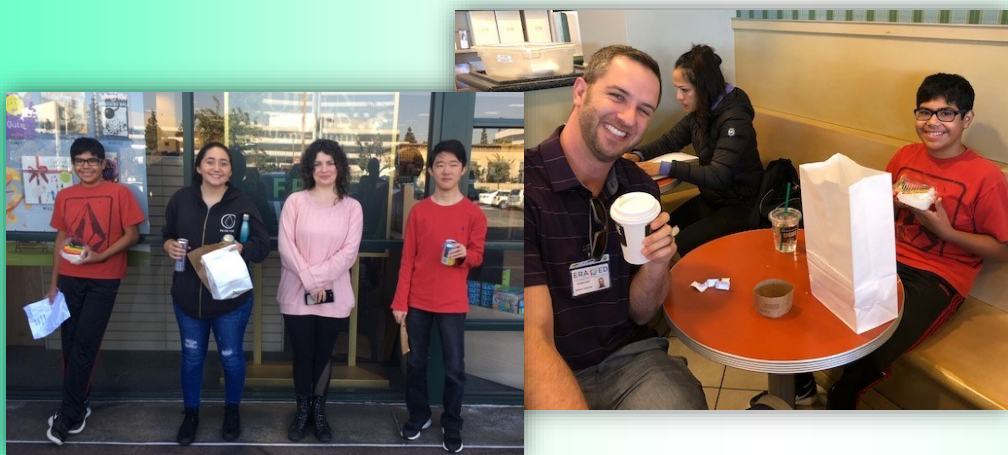

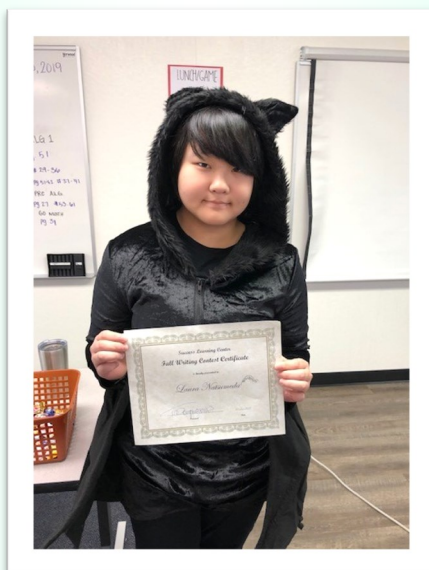
Poetry Reading at Barnes and Noble Cafe
