## Reading Follett eBooks and Audiobooks

Follett eBooks put you in control of your reading experience. From any device, you can listen to an eBook, change font sizes, create notes and bookmarks, and jump to any page – in just a few clicks.

Here's a closer look at what you'll see when you click an icon in an eBook's header.

**Main Menu**

- Offline Access**: Save your eBook to read offline.
- Offline Content Library**: Access the eBooks you saved for offline reading.
- TABLE OF CONTENTS**: Browse chapter names and click to go directly to that place in the book.

**Display Options**

The options you see depend on the format of the eBook.

- FONT**: Drag the slider, or click A- or A+ to decrease or increase the font size.
- PAGE LAYOUT**: Switch between single- and double-page views. Click **Auto** to return to the view set by the publisher.
- THEMES**: Click a color swatch to change the background and font color.
- ZOOM TO FIT BY**: Use to set the page size to the height or width of your display.

<p><b>Audio Speed</b></p> 	<p>Drag the slider to decrease or increase the audio speed.</p>
<p><b>Bookmarks</b></p> 	<p>Click to add a bookmark so you can easily mark your place.</p>
<p><b>Sleep Timer</b></p> 	<p>Drag the slider to set a time for stopping playback. If you select <b>End</b>, the audio stops at the end of the current chapter.</p>
