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## Overview

The 14-15 results for the 3-8 assessments were severely compromised by the large number of opt outs. With just slightly less than 50% of the students opting out, the results do not give a true picture of the academic attainments of the students in Washingtonville. However, the School Report Card uses these results and, therefore, the Committee reviewed the results. The Regents results from the High School are viable and give us a good source of data.

The District did not make AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) for participation since our participation rate was below the 95% threshold. However, all of the buildings are in good standing.

Each principal was asked to review all aspects of their buildings and report to the Executive Committee on their building's strengths and areas in need of improvement. This information was included in this final report.

In addition, the Executive Committee looked at all of the data and reports to analyze it from a District perspective.
