OUR MISSION:

The Gunston School offers an intellectually rigorous, highly personalized, and nurturing college preparatory educational experience. Valuing a healthy balance between mind and body, a strong sense of community, the creative process, and our connection to the Chesapeake Bay, Gunston strives to educate ethically and environmentally minded scholars, citizens, and leaders for our globalized society.

Admission and Enrollment

Admission to the Gunston School is selective and based on an applicant's previous school records, standardized testing, teacher recommendations, and a personal interview. Students enter Gunston as bright and energetic adolescents and graduate as intellectually and socially confident mature young adults ready to meet the demands of college with diligence and grace. Total enrollment for the 2019–2020 academic year stands at 210 students, 20 of whom are international students living with host families in the surrounding community.

LOCATION AND HISTORY

Situated on 35-acres on the picturesque Corsica River in Centreville, Maryland, the Gunston School was founded by Sam and Mary Middleton in 1911. Their original Victorian home houses the school's administrative offices. Since its founding, the school has added numerous academic, communal, and athletic facilities in support of students' intellectual, social, and physical development.

DISTINCTIVE PROGRAMS

Chesapeake Bay Studies

Students complete a week-long Bay Studies experience each year. Bay Studies draws on both outside agencies such as Outward Bound and the Chesapeake Bay Foundation as well as on Gunston's own faculty to explore the various components of life in and around the Chesapeake Bay including environmental studies, history, and social and cultural influences. Primarily experiential, Bay Studies incorporates field trips, analysis of primary sources, in depth study of specific topics, discussion, journal writing, lab work, and computer analysis.

Gunston Writing Experience

Junior Symposium: In the fall, students select an author of focus and spend the balance of the school year reading five of the author's works and researching the author's life. From their reading, they devise an original thesis statement reflecting their synthesis of the author's works.

Senior Paradigm Project: Students complete a summative narrative of how their years at Gunston shaped their own 'language of values.' We ask students to create their own value model by examining key moments of insight in the areas of Experiences, People, and Knowledge.

Waterfront Sports Program

One-third of students participate in crew or sailing. In 2016 crew placed 3rd in Maryland State Championships, semifinalists in SRAA National and raced in the prestigious Head of the Charles in Boston, Mass. In 2017, placed 3rd in Maryland State Championships and semi finalists in SRAA National Championship in New Jersey.

Near Space Balloon Launch

The goal of this project is to use a helium-filled weather balloon to take cameras and scientific instruments to "near space," a region above the majority of the Earth's atmosphere that begins at 65,000 feet. Photos taken in near space show the blackness of space and resemble photos taken from orbit. Gunston plans to launch balloons each year, with the goal of reaching higher altitudes and adding more scientific instrumentation to investigate the properties of the stratosphere and the ozone layer.

Senior Internships

Seniors who meet established criteria have the opportunity to work in an area of interest to them in lieu of taking final examinations. The program lasts approximately two weeks at the end of the senior year.

Chesapeake Watershed Semester

Utilizing the Chesapeake Bay and its watershed as the foundation for an immersive, rigorous, and interdisciplinary curriculum, the Chesapeake Semester is a single-semester, place-based academic program for high school juniors and seniors. The program aims to cultivate reflective and confident students and leaders who can promote regional and global environmental sustainability through their understanding of scientific, social, cultural, and political systems.



PROGRAM:

The Gunston School endorses a student-centered philosophy that encourages achievement and personal growth by emphasizing the balanced development of the whole student—intellectually, morally, culturally, and physically.

The academic requirements for graduation include a minimum of 24 credits across the following content areas:

- Foreign Language 3 credits 3 credits in Spanish or 2 credits in Spanish and two credits in a second World Language via a school approved online learning provider.
- History 3 credits including courses in United States History and American Government
- Math 3 credits including courses in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II
- Science 3 credits in laboratory science including courses in Biology, Chemistry, and Wellness
- Computer Science -- .25 credit
- Art & Music 2 credits-...5 credit per year
- Athletics 2 credits-students must participate in two seasons of athletics per year
- Chesapeake Bay Studies 1 credit—students earn .25 credit each year through successful completion of the program
- Community Service: 15 hours for incoming seniors, 30 hours for incoming juniors, 45 hours for incoming freshmen and sophomores

Courses taken through an approved, accredited program are listed on the student's Gunston transcript. Distinctions: "High Honors" is earned with an average of 93 or higher. "Honors" is earned with an average of 90 or higher.

Disciplinary Reporting: As an institutional member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC), Gunston will disclose disciplinary infractions resulting in suspension or dismissal to colleges and universities to which the student applied.
