

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to Centerville City Schools. Our health care team would like to take this opportunity to share important information with you regarding the district's School Health Services. Health services are provided by licensed school nurses and registered nurses who work collaboratively to keep students healthy, safe and ready to learn.

If your child has any health concerns or requires specialized nursing care, please contact the school nurse in your child's building. The school nurse will develop and implement a health care plan.

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Medication Administration at School

If your child will need prescription and/or non-prescription medication while at school a doctor's order is required. The appropriate form(s) must be completed by the child's licensed healthcare professional, signed by parent giving authorization and reviewed by the Centerville City School nurse. All medication and forms must be brought to the school by a parent or guardian. We have the following forms available in our clinics and online in the student/parent section forms/documents www.centerville.k12.oh.us

- ❖ **Permit for Dispensing Prescription/Non-Prescription Medication to Students**
*This form is for any medication prescription or over the counter that is to be given at school.
This form is not needed if an Allergy and/or Asthma plan is completed.*
- ❖ **Emergency Allergy Plan/Epinephrine Authorization**
This form is used for allergies that require emergency medications as treatment such as food allergies and insect allergies.
- ❖ **Asthma Action Plan/Inhaled Asthma Medication Authorization**
This form is for a student who requires the use of inhalers/nebulizers for the treatment of their asthma.

Ohio State Immunization requirements for school attendance:

Parents/Guardians are required to provide proof of immunizations when enrolling a student to the district. **No student shall be permitted to remain in school for more than 14 days** if this requirement is not met. If you have questions about immunization requirements for school, please contact the school nurse in your child's building. You can request your child's previous school to email a copy of your child's immunizations to the school nurse in your child's building.

7th grade vaccine requirements prior to entry: Tdap booster after age 7 & Meningococcal not before age 11

12th grade vaccine requirements prior to entry: 2 doses of Meningococcal, one dose after age 16.
