General: Following the success of Shrewsbury International School Bangkok Riverside where 1700 students study in one of South East Asia's top performing schools, a brand new second campus has opened in the heart of the city in August 2018.

Shrewsbury International School Bangkok (City Campus) shares the same values, ethos and mission of the Riverside Campus and caters exclusively for primary aged children. 672 places are available from Early Years 1 (Age 3+) to Year 6 (Ages 11+)

Both campuses come together to form Shrewsbury International School Bangkok and children from City Campus will graduate to Riverside in Year 7 (Age 12+)

City Campus has established its own unique identity and the two campuses integrate and liaise with each other creating exciting opportunities for both children and for staff.

The school itself is operating on 25,000SQM of learning space. There are 4 major buildings, which have the capacity to fit 672 students. A dance studio, air con gym, canteen, swimming pools, football pitch and running track are all designed bespoke for primary aged children.

The classrooms are designed with flexibility in mind for different learning styles and collaboration. They are fitted with Furnware furniture and Community Playthings; a natural environment creating an oasis in the city.

The link with Shrewsbury School UK (www.shrewsbury.org.uk) is taken very seriously and, year-on-year, develops into a world-class educational partnership.

Responsibilities: The Support Technician (Design Technology):

- is responsible to the Line Manager assigned by The Principal. In normal circumstances, this will be the Head of Department
- will work closely with other teachers within the assigned department.

Tasks: The Support Technician (Design Technology) will:

- provide classroom support in subject areas of specialist interest;
- provide, under close and monitored supervision from Head of Department or other teachers within the department, one-to-one tuition of students in subject areas of specialist interest knowledge;
- play a lead role in developing the Learning Environment / Display in assigned subject areas;
- support teachers with planning and administrative tasks;
- where appropriate have the opportunity to team teach and lead classes;
- provide good practical and workshop skills e.g. textiles, woodwork, use of the Laser Cutter.
- organize and maintain material stock and supplies;
- manage and maintain workshop resources, tools and equipment;
- work closely with students and to offer practical help and advice under guidance from Head of Department / specialist teachers;
- be fully involved with other aspects of school life;

- lead and supervise any temporary support/maintenance staff allocated to assist within the department;
- Source and purchase materials from suppliers as directed by Head of Department.

Expectations:

The Support Technician (Design Technology):

- be a strong team player with a clear understanding of his / her professional responsibilities;
- will provide a varied and creative approach to EAL provision and actively support school initiative in this field;
- will have a strong commitment to teamwork and be highly pro-active in working with staff, students and parents;
- will demonstrate a keen eye for detail in assessing students;
- will have excellent organizational skills;
- will be aware of and adhere to standards of best practice in regard to Health and Safety;
- will be positive, patient, flexible and punctual;
- have an energetic approach to work;
- enjoy working as part of a successful team;
- be able to work independently and to use ICT effectively.

Child
