- Lead children in an afterschool arts program
- Plant trees in a reforestation project
- Swim in a natural geothermal spring
- Learn about the Mayan cosmology and calendar

- Explore the ancient Mayan ruins at Iximche
- Test their Spanish knowledge and learn words in the local K'iche' language
- Visit the gorgeous colonial city of Antigua
- Share a life-changing experience with VES friends while making new friends
