January 10 <sup>th</sup>	Mandatory forum for MIT parents and students, (letters of Intent provided)
January 10 <sup>th</sup>	MIT and all surrounding schools (open enrollment flyer) sent
January 10 <sup>th</sup>	Non-Vaughn parents/students can start picking up letters of Intent
January 24 <sup>TH</sup>	Make-up Mandatory Forum for MIT parents/students
February 4 <sup>TH</sup>	Non-Vaughn parent forum
February 19 <sup>TH</sup>	Deadline to return "Letter of Intent" for MIT and Non-Vaughn parents
February 27 <sup>TH</sup>	Lottery for Non-Vaughn parents
March 12 <sup>TH</sup>	Acceptance / Non-Acceptance letters to be mailed out
April 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Deadline to turn in lottery acceptance letters
April 16 <sup>th</sup>	Non-Vaughn students placement test & parents enrollment orientation
April 30 <sup>th</sup>	Deadline for Non-Vaughn enrollment packets

### Notes:

- ❖ All MIT students will be accepted – If they submit all paper work on time
- ❖ MIT parents need to sign in on their student’s teacher roster to prove they attended the mandatory orientation in order to receive a Letter of intent
