Frequently Asked Questions

- Q.** May I apply to a four-year university without penalty?
A. YES. Your college admissions process is the same as for other high school seniors.
- Q.** Will I earn college and high school credits?
A. NO for CN & YES if needed towards HS graduation; De Anza courses will appear on your De Anza transcript for college credit.
- Q.** May I participate in my high school GRADUATION?
A. YES.
- Q.** May I still participate in CLUBS & SPORTS at my high school?
A. YES with Activities AP approval.
- Q.** May I GRADUATE EARLY?
A. NO. Only your high school campus can allow you to graduate early.

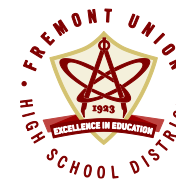

COLLEGE NOW PROGRAM

- **WHY:** Complete 1 yr of college @ fraction of university cost while earning college credits w/o AP tests
- **WHY:** Finished FUHSD class options; want more class choices
- **WHAT:** Senior year school days split between FUHSD periods 1 & 2 @ HS and De Anza College classes
- **WHO:** FUHSD Juniors who will have at least 200 credits at end of 2nd smstr 11th grade
- **WHO:** FUHSD Juniors getting ahead in college before a HS grad
- **HOW:** only need Economics/US Government & the 4th year of English to graduate
- **HOW:** Submit CN Questionnaire between January-March
- **YEAR TO APPLY:** Junior
- **YEAR PARTICIPATION:** Senior
- **WHERE:** on HS campus for periods 1 & 2 only
- **WHERE:** on De Anza College campus when you decide
- **HS PARTICIPATION:** clubs, activities, sports permitted w/ HS Activities Admin permission
- **De Anza REGISTRATION PRIORITY:** 3rd highest
- **CALENDAR:** Both FUHSD & De Anza calendars (Aug-end of June)
- **COST:** Pay for 12-21.5 De Anza units every quarter**

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

- **WHY:** Want to take a De Anza College class while staying full-time @ HS
- **WHY:** Take course not offered @ HS; try a college level course; have free time
- **WHY:** CN eligibility; make up credits
- **WHAT:** Take up to 11.5 units a quarter (2 classes) during school year and only 6 units (1 class) in the summer
- **WHO:** Juniors & Seniors
- **WHO:** Sophomores are Juniors starting the summer after their sophomore year
- **HOW:** #1-Complete the De Anza College online application for the desired quarter
- **HOW:** #2-After receiving De Anza ID# via email, complete the HS Permission forms and return to the De Anza Admissions
- **HOW:** #3-Register online for desired class(es) on designated date through De Anza College student account [MyPortal]
- **De Anza REGISTRATION PRIORITY:** 8th – lowest possible
- **CALENDAR:** De Anza College, not FUHSD
- **COST:** Pay for books, parking, Student Fees, but not any “per unit fees” upon Residency**; no Financial Aid

**“Non-residents” as determined by De Anza may be subject to De Anza out-of-state fees & some international students may not be eligible based on visa status – please see the following website for more information:

MIDDLE COLLEGE PROGRAM

- **WHY:** Need new educational setting for academic, social, and/or personal reasons
- **WHY:** Need safe environment to be yourself
- **NOT TO:** Take courses not offered @ HS or try college classes
- **NOT TO:** Get ahead or college app
- **WHAT:** Spend junior and/or senior year(s) on De Anza College campus, earning HS & college credits
- **WHAT:** Quarterly (2) De Anza College academic courses & (2) FUHSD English & SS
- **WHO:** FUHSD Sophomores & Juniors who exhibit a true need to participate the following year
- **HOW:** Submit MC Application, 2 Tchr Evaluations, an essay, & interview between January-March
- **YEARS TO APPLY:** Soph & Jr
- **YRS PARTICIPATION:** Jr & Sr
- **WHERE:** De Anza College campus
- **HS PARTICIPATION:** clubs, activities, sports permitted w/ HS Activities Admin permission
- **De Anza REGISTRATION PRIORITY:** 3rd highest
- **CALENDAR:** De Anza College, not FUHSD
- **COST:** Books, parking, & materials if take less than 12 units a quarter
