

### Level Blue Privileges

- Attends all regular education and specialist classes
- All recess
- Can purchase dice roll on Friday
- Can fulfill class job
- Can attend "Awesome Activity" (Usually on Fridays) ( if 3 days on level or higher)
- Free name in bucket ticket (drawing at the end of the month for a cool prize)
- Teacher spin bonus points
- Free bathroom coupon
- Free drink coupon
- MP3 player privileges
- "Fab-Bag" draw if 0 negatives for the day




### Level Green Privileges

- Attends all regular education and specialist classes
- All recess
- Can purchase dice roll on Friday
- Can fulfill class job
- Can attend "Awesome Activity" (Usually on Fridays) ( if 3 days on level or higher)
- "Fab-bag" draw if 0 negatives for the day



## Level Orange Privileges

- Attends all regular education and specialist classes
- 5 minutes of recess on a spot
- Can purchase dice roll on Friday
- Can attend "Awesome Activity" (Usually on Fridays)( if 3 days on level or higher)
- "Fab-bag" draw if 0 negatives for the day.



### Level Red Privileges

- Attends all regular education and specialist classes
- 10 minutes of recess on a spot.
- No other privileges (field trips, extra regular education activities, assemblies, etc.)

- "Fab-bag" draw if 0 negatives for the day.

10 negative points

### Level Yellow Privileges

- Receives all instruction in the learning center setting.
- All recesses on a spot outside
- No other privileges (i.e. dice roll, assemblies, extra regular education activities, and field trips)
- Eat lunch in the learning center at the seat away desk

- "Fab-bag" draw if 0 negatives for the day

After Two full Days on Level Yellow Students move

### Excluded Member (White)

Students are moved here when they have been on level yellow for two consecutive school days. The student sits in seat away. They do not get teacher or student attention. They have no recesses and eat their lunch in the non-member area. Students must complete class work and a Behavior Debriefing Form. After spending the whole day as a non-member in our classroom the student will buy back up to level blue at the cost of 40 points. This keeps students from staying on level yellow and giving up hope causing them to not advance behaviorally or academically.

# Exception Clauses to the Level System

Students sometimes exhibit behaviors that are extreme in nature which greatly impede their own academic instruction and the academic instruction of other students. When students exhibit the following behaviors they receive an automatic level drop or automatic double level drop not requiring the usual 10 negative marks on their daily level sheet:

## Automatic level drop Misbehaviors

- Excessive non-compliance
- Removed from a group
- Homework not completed or not completely neatly

- Home note not returned
- Leaving room without permission
- Daily class work not completed at the end of the day
- Staff Shopping
- Cheating

## Automatic Double Level drop Misbehaviors

- Excessive verbal aggression (swearing)
- Throwing objects
- Physical aggression towards self, others, or property
- Destroying daily level sheet or making marks without permission
- Stealing
