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Healthcare Changes

The State of Washington is taking over the health plans for medical, dental and vision care for all school employees across the state effective Jan. 1, 2020. This new insurance program, managed by the School Employees Benefits Board (SEBB) of the Washington State Health Care Authority, will have open enrollment between Oct. 1 and Nov. 15, 2019.

SEBB aims to standardize benefits, rules, and costs for those working in K-12 education across the state. All staff who work at least 630 hours in a school year qualify for full benefits. You must choose a benefits plan or waive coverage to not be automatically enrolled in a plan by the state.

There are many significant changes to your healthcare coverage resulting from this transition to SEBB and the district is here to support and guide you and your families through this process.

- Attest to the spouse or state-registered domestic partner coverage and tobacco premium surcharges
- Waive coverage for yourself (employees only)
- Add dependents (you must provide proof of your dependent's eligibility before they can be enrolled).


Actions you can take using SEBB My Account year-round

- View your coverage information (employees and dependents)
 - View your coverage information (Continuation Coverage - January 1, 2020)
- View your basic employer-paid life and AD&D insurance information (employees only)
- View your long-term disability insurance information (employees only)
- Download your statement of insurance
- View your premium surcharge attestations (if applicable)
- Make changes to your tobacco use premium surcharge attestation (if applicable)
- Make changes based on qualifying events specified in the SEBB Program rules


