



## Ministry of Defence Continuity of Education Allowance (MOD CEA)

Our boarding fees are discounted for those in receipt of MOD CEA. The MOD insists that eligible personnel make a minimum contribution of 10% towards the school fees, but they will not fund more than the maximum amount that they set each year as boarding school fees are generally far above this figure. As a result the minimum parental contribution permissible under MOD CEA rules will be made.

For the current school year 2019/20, the actual fees at the Royal Hospital School are £34,140 for pupils in Year 9 and above and the discount awarded is £8,046 resulting in a net fee of £26,094. Therefore, after deducting the MOD CEA maximum award of £23,484, the parental contribution for 2019/20 is £2,610.
