



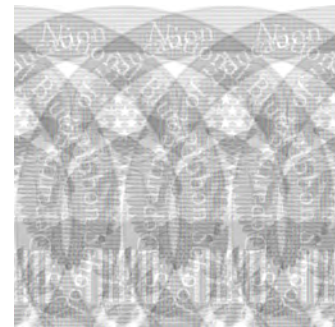

The mission of Lemont High School is for all students to become life-long, independent learners and productive citizens in a rapidly changing world.

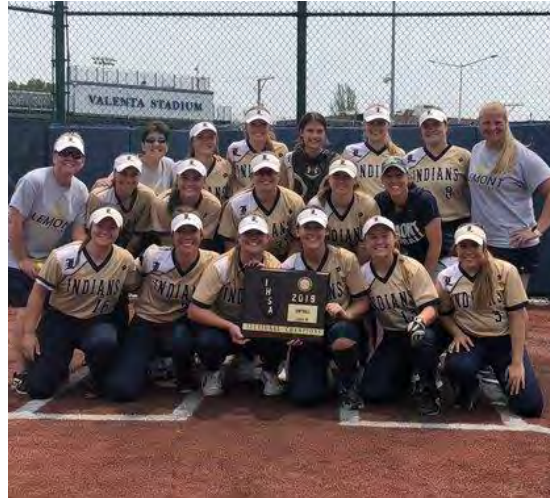


Unique Place

Staff

- 96% teacher retention rate
- Faculty average approximately 14 years experience at Lemont High School!
- Several teachers are Lemont High School graduates, and even more live in town and have sent (or will send) their children to Lemont High School
- 83% hold a Master's Degree or higher
- More than two-thirds of our faculty are coaches or sponsors



Academics

- Class of 2019's SAT Composite Average was tops among Southland schools
- SAT Composite Average for:
 - Top 10%-1372-92%
 - Top 20%-1328-89%
 - Top 50%-1233-80%
- ACT Composite Average for:
 - Top 10% - 29.7-93%
 - Top 20% - 28.4-90%
 - Top 50% 26.3-86%



Academics

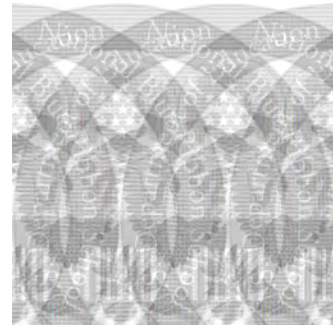
- AP Exams - 504 students combined for 917 exams - 70% scored 3 or better
- 2019 - 352 students pass at least one AP exam; 2014- 229 students take AP
- Traditionally, more than 90 percent of graduates continue their education
- 97% of last year's freshmen are "on track" according to ISBE
- 44% of all students were enrolled in "advanced coursework" last year, including 70% of the Class of 2019

CITGO Innovation Academy STEM Talent Pipeline

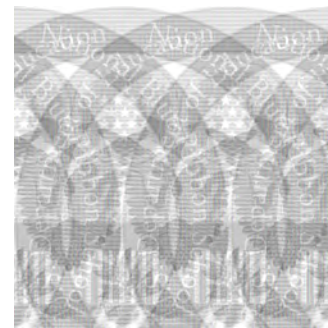
The key component of the STEM Talent Pipeline is its support of the Citgo Innovation Academies

- CITGO partners with local schools to support STEM programming, professional development, and outreach
- Partners are officially designated as CITGO Innovation Academies by their districts
- CITGO Innovation Academies have access to STEM Talent Pipeline resources, including scholarships
- Lemont is the first school in Illinois to become an Innovation Academy and one of only two high schools in the country
