Music Scholarships to Senior Schools

We are fortunate in teaching exceptionally able children. A significant number of pupils gain awards to the public school of their choice. In the past five years we have gained 8 scholarships and 5 exhibitions.

If you would like to explore the possibility of your child applying for a Music Award there is some general guideline information below and I would be very pleased to discuss with you further information about specific requirements of your child's chosen school.

Music Scholarship Guidelines

An Exhibitioner will be a musical Grade 5+ on one instrument and possibly also offer singing or another instrument to a basic level.

Any piano or harmony instrument (guitar, harp, piano, organ) would be a bonus as this will really help with GCSE, a requirement for those who have music awards.

A Scholar will usually be Grade 6+ on two instruments or excel on one and be Grade 3/4 on another.

The same applies re. a harmony instrument.

Whilst Grades are a signpost, senior schools are looking first and foremost at musical potential, musician engagement/communication and particularly enthusiasm.
