

Physical Education Excuse

A parent/guardian may excuse a student from physical education for up to two days. Any long term physical education excuse must be requested in writing from the student's health care provider, specifying the length of time your child is to be exempted. A written note from the health care provider should be submitted for the student to resume full activities.

Any child who is exempt from physical education for medical reasons will not be allowed to participate in outdoor recess activities. Re-injury on the playground could occur, resulting in prolonging the child's healing and recovery period. Arrangements for indoor recess in the main office or a supervised classroom will be made.
