Exhibit B—Notice of Refusal of Entry to or Ejection of an Individual from District Property

In accordance with Education Code 37.105, you are being refused entry to or ejected from property under the control of _____ School District because you have refused to leave peaceably upon request and either posed a substantial risk of harm or continued to behave in a manner that is inappropriate for a school setting after being given a verbal warning.

A person appealing under the District's grievance process will be permitted to address the Board in person within 90 days of filing the initial complaint, unless the complaint is resolved before reaching the Board.

Appeals regarding refusal of entry of ejection from district property may be filed in accordance with FNG(LOCAL)—Student and Parent Com-plaints/Grievances and GF(LOCAL)—Public Complaints.

Exhibit C—Website Notice Regarding the Refusal of Entry to or Ejection of an Individual from District Property

The District has the right to refuse entry to or eject a person from property under the District's control if the person refuses to leave peaceably upon request and:

1. The individual poses a substantial risk of harm to any person, or
2. The individual continues to behave in a manner inappropriate for the school setting after having received a verbal or written warning to cease the inappropriate behavior.

A person ejected from or refused entry to property under this provision may appeal this action by filing an appeal under FNG(LOCAL) or GF(LOCAL) and will be permitted to address the Board in person within 90 days of filing the initial complaint, unless the complaint is resolved before reaching the Board.
