In **French**: Rebekah Kerr was joint 1<sup>st</sup>, Ailbhe Rea and Lalana Songra joint 2<sup>nd</sup> while Clare Gray was 2<sup>nd</sup> in **Spanish**. In **Economics** Jessica Chen was 2<sup>nd</sup> and John Finlay 3<sup>rd</sup>, and Tess Davidson came 3<sup>rd</sup> in **History**.

On the basis of their outstanding A Level results Clare Gray was awarded an entrance scholarship by Trinity College Dublin, while Hannah Chambers, Yasmin Finlay and Saorse McClean received an equivalent award from UCD.
