Cathedral's Advanced Placement classes can change a student's life. Opportunities to excel

More than thirty-five percent of Cathedral's student body participates in AP courses, and the average class size is sixteen. Earn college credit

The state legislature and the Indiana Department of Education value AP courses to such an extent that they now require all publicly supported Indiana colleges or universities to award credit to students who earn scores of 3, 4, or 5 on their AP exams.
