



### **SAFETY**

Student safety is our top priority. Our Safety Office is committed to ensuring a safe learning environment for students, faculty, staff, and guests of the University by providing high quality service with excellent standards of personal integrity and ethics. The University's Safety Office is staffed 24/7 with highly trained officers. Emergency call boxes are placed throughtout campus as well.

### PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION

First year students, unless they are commuters, are not permitted to bring their vehicle to campus. Public transportation is available as well as the university shuttle that has regularly scheduled visits to shopping centers and attractions through out the surrounding community.

#### **RESIDENCE HALLS**

Misericordia University offers several dormitories, townhomes, and off-campus housing. Townhomes and off-campus housing are typically reserved for upper classmen.

#### STUDENT HEALTH & WELLNESS CENTER

The Health & Wellness Center is located in the Anderson Sports and Health Center and provides students with a nursing assessment and treatment for common illnesses on a walk-in basis as well as advanced assessments by the Nurse Practitioner (by appointment only). If necessary, particularly after hours and on weekends, students are advised to seek treatment at one of the area hospitals (Geisinger Hospital or Wilkes Barre General Hospital) or at one of the local MedExpress Urgent Care Centers.
